


"They are my dream family!"

Our vision is to see every child protected within the love of a family. But this work depends on families inviting a child into their home. When a child is referred to us we first look for safe family members. If none are found, we find or provide safe excellent short-term care while we pray for God to move the perfect family to adopt.

This is a story of God doing just that for one little boy. His story is beautiful and hard, at the same time.

You see, he was abandoned at birth by his first family. This was likely not malicious but his family didn't see how they could care for him. We became a soft place for this boy to land and be loved but we always prayed that someday he'd have a family of his own.

At one point, we thought we had found him a family, but it just wasn't quite the right fit. This element is important to understand. When we are looking to care for orphaned and vulnerable children, it is not a quantity issue.



While we were praying, the Lord was working within a local family. One who is closely tied within our GCA family, so this little boy has encountered them often. They have even provided respite care for him at times.

When our social worker got to pull this boy aside and tell him that this family would like to bring home... finally and fully home... as a son... not a temporary guest, but a son...

His response? "They are my dream family!"

This is our hope and our dream for every child growing up without a family. This is why we are working to reimagine child protection globally... So that more children can be safely protected within a loving family. Yes, it's important that we work as quickly as possible to get as many kids into families as we can while working to ensure every child can say... "this is my dream family."

This is possible, friends. At GCA, we're committed to this end. We'll keep laboring, we'll keep pushing, we'll keep praying. Thank you for being with us!

SOJOURN Artisan Spotlight:

Mway Mway

Mway Mway grew up in a large family with six siblings and her parents struggled to provide. To help pay off her family debt, Mway Mway decided to quit school at age eleven and look for work. The job she found was seven hours away in Thailand's largest city, working as a maid for a family she had never met. After a year and a half of hard work, she finally earned enough to pay off the debt and Mway Mway was able to return back home to Mae Sot.



That is when the Sojourn Studio team met her. We invited Mway Mway to join our vocational training program for teens. Her natural talent and determination quickly made her one of our best artisans. We have watched Mway Mway's personality completely transform through the community of love and support we've cultivated in our studio, into a confident young woman, full of spunk.

Mway Mway got married at seventeen years old and began working full-time soon after. Despite making a living wage, she struggled to save any money because she always helps out family members when they have needs. Because of our amazing buyers, Sojourn Studio has been able to provide consistent work hours and Mway Mway now has a savings fund of her own. She has scholarship funds available to her to make up for the education she never received.



All of which she has fully earned... not as a beneficiary but as a professional artist.

When she gave birth to her first child this fall, like many other women from Myanmar, Mway Mway was treated as a third-class citizen. Under the guise of Covid-19, the nursing staff sent her home but kept her son at the hospital for the very first two weeks of his life. She was devastated.

During this emotional rollercoaster as a new young mom, Mway Mway was surrounded by support. They helped her cope, and our staff used their voice to elevate hers so she could finally bring her son home from the hospital.

For all of you who have purchased jewelry from Sojourn Studio or one of our partners, thank you for providing dignified work AND empowering a beautiful community of sisterhood for women from Myanmar.
